PASTOR'S NOTE:

The Synod of Bishops of our Ukrainian Catholic Church voted on new translations for the Divine Liturgy, and requested that we implement them in all of our churches. Fr. Kury began the process by purchasing new books for the choir members. They have been using the approved translation for a while. Next week copies of the approved books will be available for use in our pews. You will have two options: **one**, a small blue book (Ukr/Eng) with text only, and **two**, a larger blue book with music, changeable parts for feasts, and extras.
